## Community Lab Blood Screening

CCCS in conjunction with Windber Medical Center will be having a blood screening on Saturday, September 21 from 7:00-10:00 a.m. in the Pike Grace Family Center.

The cost of the screening is \$30. The items listed for the screening are: CBC (hematocrit, Hemoglobin, MCV, MPV, Platelets, RBC, WBC Differential), Albumin, Alk. Phosphatase, Bilirubin, Direct & To-

tal BUN, Calcium, Chloride, Cholesterol, CO<sub>2</sub>, Creatinine, Free T<sub>4</sub>, GFR, GGT, Glucose, HDL, Iron, LDH, LDL, Phosphorus, Potassium, ALT, AST, Sodium, total Protein, Triglyceride, TSH, Uric Acid) As you can see, It's quite extensive. For an additional fee of \$20 each, they will check PSA & Hemoglobin A1C.

Also offered will be free lung screening and blood pressure

checks will be offered.

If you'd like to schedule an appointment, call 814-467-3961. Appointments are NOT necessary.

There needs to be a 12-14 hour fast for this blood work.

This is a fundraiser for our athletic department. For each person that has the screening, \$5 profit goes to CCCS.
