We plan to take an evening and bake gobs for the sale here at the Family Center. More information will be sent home as that date gets closer.

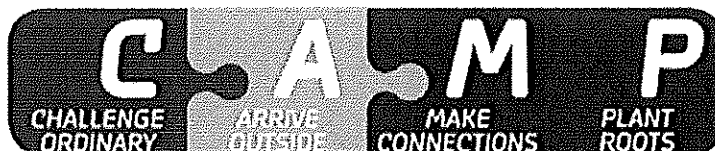

Scrapbooking Extravaganza

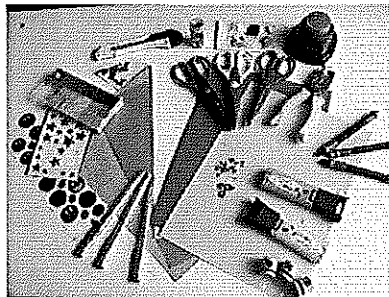
Our Spring Scrapbooking Extravaganza will be held on Friday, April 4 & Saturday, April 5.

Oh yes, we would love to have some desserts donated for this event too. Call the school and let us know how you can help.



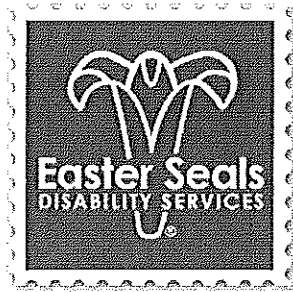
Phone Calls to Teachers

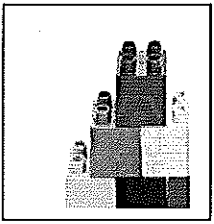

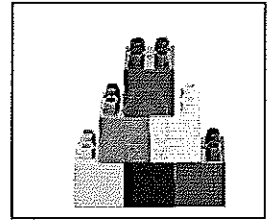
