All you have to do is get on line at www.shopwithscrip.com and set up an account. You can pay on line by setting up a PrestoPay account or send the payment to the school. Choose the cards you would like to purchase and click send. It really is that easy. The order will be placed on Mondays and the cards are here for distribution on Wednesday afternoons.
