Change for Change Update

The preschool and elementary Change for Change Drive was a success!

The preschool classes raised \$387.50 to help the World Vision "Alive to Five" program keep children in impoverished areas alive to the age of 5 by given them vaccinations, nutritional food and other needed services.

Kindergarten through 6th grade raised a collective amount of \$294.44.

The totals for the Elementary are:

1st Place—3rd grade with a total of \$95.54 raised to help give orphans clothing and shelter

2nd place—4th A& 5th grades with a total of \$87.32 to help exploited women and children

3rd place—6th grade with a total of \$67.76 to buy Bibles to be distributed around the world

4th place—1st & 2nd grade with a total of \$43.82 to buy farm animals to help impoverished families sustain an income and food source.

CCCS Formal Announcement

The **high school formal** will be held on Saturday, May 9th, 2015 beginning at 4:00 p.m. at Flood City Cafe. All students in **grades 9-12** are invited to join in this extravagant affair. Students will be provided with live music from a C.C.C.S. alumni, Mr. Adam Ciner, as well as a menu of food that they have chosen, specialty coffee drinks, and tasty desserts. The formal event will conclude at 7:00 p.m. The cost will be \$20 a person to the formal event. *For couples:* \$40 a couple who is not attending after-formal and \$50 a couple that is attending the after-formal. Students who are bringing friends or guests with them to the formal *or* after-formal need to have a school permission slip filled out if the student does not attend C.C.C.S.

After-formal is open to all students in **grades 7-12** and will be from **8:00 p.m. until midnight at the Pike Grace Family Center**. The cost will be \$10 a person. This fee will help off-set the cost of the activities that are provided such as the Rock Wall, Bungee Basketball, and a surprise game from Windswept Inc. Again, Students who are bringing friends or guests with them to the formal *or* after-formal need to have a school permission slip filled out if the student does not attend C.C.C.S. This can be obtained from Mrs. Walker.

All money for the formal will be due by Thursday, April 30th, so that payments can be made to vendors on Friday, May 1. Unfortunately, late decisions to attend the formal can not be accepted as the count for food will need to be in on May 1.

Additionally, due to the water damage, Mrs. Walker (a.k.a. Miss R.) was unable to continue the candy store's fundraising efforts for formal. God is good! The funds she had collected are close to what she needed to rent the venue, Bungee Basketball, and the rock wall. The small remaining balance due will be covered by the students' cost of admission to the after-formal. However, she is concerned about not having the funds in the account to provide enough snacks for the amount of students that are projected to attend. If you are willing to donate any "goodies" (chips, cookies, pop, anything edible...), she would greatly appreciate it!
