## SAT Prep

Beginning May 1<sup>st</sup>, Mrs. Walker will be offering small group SAT tutoring sessions again in her classroom from 3:30-4:30 p.m. This will take place on Fridays during the month of May, which is open to **anyone** who is interested. The course will cover basic test strategies, set-up of the English sections and different question type. Each week the lesson focuses on a different aspect of English – writing, sentence structure, reading comprehension, etc. Students in 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> grade may be interested in taking this course in order to know what to expect, in order to focus on strengthening areas of concern during the following academic year. If your student is interested in taking this course and you are not sure if it will be beneficial for them at this point, feel free to contact Mrs. Walker for you detailed information on the course.

The course is five one-hour long sessions and is \$10 per session totaling \$50 for the whole course, which includes a prep packet for each week and test taking strategies that students keep.

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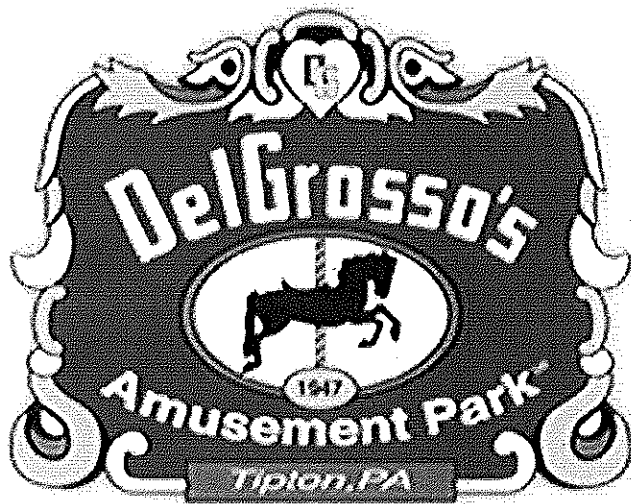

There is a boy from China that needs a host family for the 2015-2016 school year. There are other students that need host homes. Please prayerfully consider hosting a student.

It can be a great opportunity for you and your family to experience the culture of another country. You supply the student with room and board. They are responsible for all of their own expenses (ie. sports fees, lunch money, formal fees, etc.)

This program usually runs from August to June (a typical school year). We have had a few students come from January through December though.

The current families who have graciously opened their homes to these kids are Berkebile, Urban, Kestermont, McMullen. # CCCS Formal Announcement

The high school formal will be held on Saturday, May 9th, 2015 beginning at 4:00 p.m. at Flood City Cafe. All students in grades 9-12 are invited to join in this extravagant affair. Students will be provided with live music from a C.C.C.S. alumni, Mr. Adam Ciner, as well as a menu of food that they have chosen, specialty coffee drinks, and tasty desserts. The formal event will conclude at 7:00 p.m. The cost will be \$20 a person to the formal event. *For couples:* \$40 a couple who is not attending after-formal and \$50 a couple that is attending the after-formal. Students who are bringing friends or guests with them to the formal *or* after-formal need to have a school permission slip filled out if the student does not attend C.C.C.S.

After-formal is open to all students in grades 7-12 and will be from 8:00 p.m. until midnight at the Pike Grace Family Center. The cost will be \$10 a person. This fee will help off-set the cost of the activities that are provided such as the Rock Wall, Bungee Basketball, and a surprise game from Windswept Inc. Again, Students who are bringing friends or guests with them to the formal *or* after-formal need to have a school permission slip filled out if the student does not attend C.C.C.S. This can be obtained from Mrs. Walker.

All money for the formal will be due by Thursday, April 30th, so that payments can be made to vendors on Friday, May 1. Unfortunately, late decisions to attend the formal can not be accepted as the count for food will need to be in on May 1.

Additionally, due to the water damage, Mrs. Walker (a.k.a. Miss R.) was unable to continue the candy store's fundraising efforts for formal. God is good! The funds she had collected are close to what she needed to rent the venue, Bungee Basketball, and the rock wall. The small remaining balance due will be covered by the students' cost of admission to the after-formal. However, she is concerned about not having the funds in the account to provide enough snacks for the amount of students that are projected to attend. If you are willing to donate any "goodies" (chips, cookies, pop, anything edible...), she would greatly appreciate it!

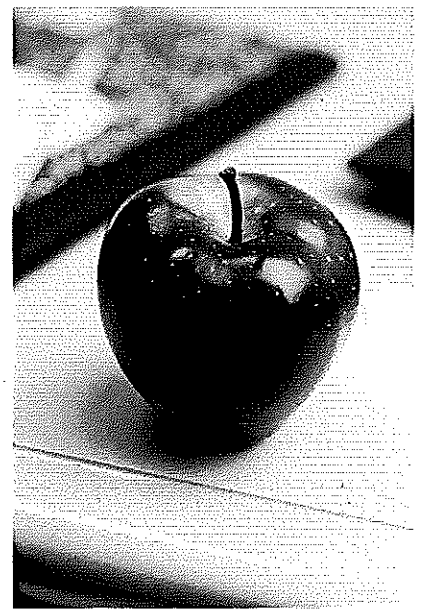
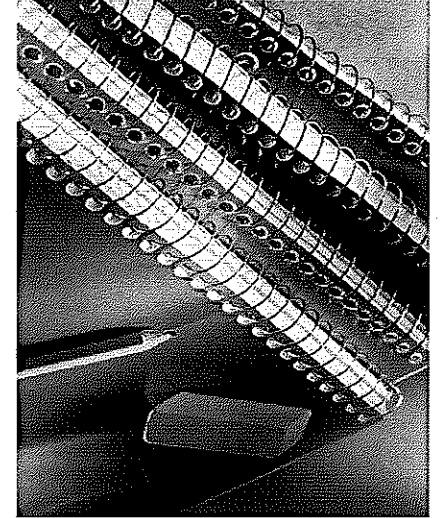
